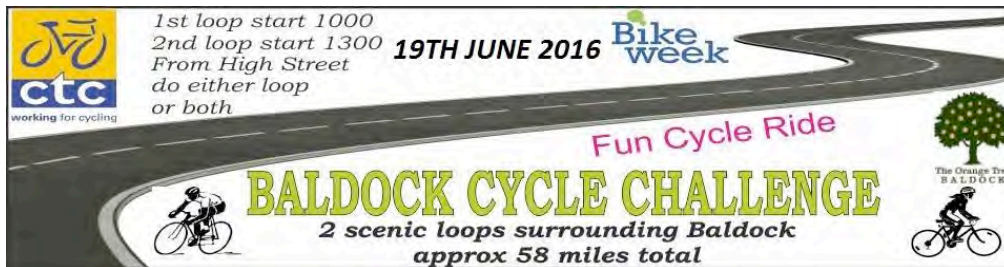
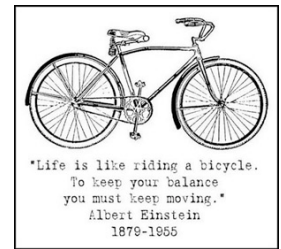




St John's Catholic Primary School

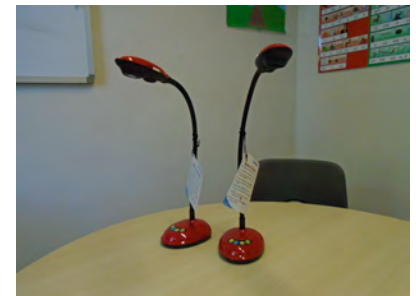
Cycling is a great way to stay healthy and it was reassuring to see so many of our children joining in and establishing habits that will promote health as they move into their teenage years and beyond.
