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Year 1 will be learning about the topic '**The Victorians**'.

As part of this day, we would like the children to come to school dressed as if they were from that period of History. A list of suggestions and example pictures of outfits can be found below:



Boys: Dark (school) trousers, white shirt with a waistcoat
Optional: Flat cap

Girls: Dress or top and skirt, white apron
Optional: White bonnet

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Year 2 will be learning about the topic '**Egyptians**'.

As part of this day, we would like the children to come to school dressed as if they were from that period of History. A list of suggestions and example pictures of outfits can be found below:



White top/dress/shirt and a piece of rope or belt to tie around the waist.
Optional: Tunic and/or headdress.

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Year 3 will be learning about the topic '**Ancient Greeks**'.

As part of this day, we would like the children to come to school dressed as if they were from that period of History. A list of suggestions and example pictures of outfits can be found below:



Girls:

Simple white tunic (made from old sheet) pinned at shoulders. (Floor length)
Belt around waist
Optional: Cloth shawl draped over shoulders and gold headdress
Sandals

Boys:

Simple white tunic (made from old sheet) pinned at shoulders. (Knee length)
Belt around waist
Optional: Piece of cloth attached around one shoulder
Sandals

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Year 4 will be learning about the topic '**The Tudors**'.

As part of this day, we would like the children to come to school dressed as if they were from that period of History. A list of suggestions and example pictures of outfits can be found below:

Girls – Long skirt and a shirt

Boys – Dark (school) trousers with a waistcoat or cloak



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Year 5 will be learning about the topic '**World War 2**'.

As part of this day, we would like the children to come to school dressed as if they were from that period of History. A list of suggestions and example pictures of outfits can be found below:



Boys: Flat caps, sleeveless jumpers, plain shirts and shoes.

Girls: Plain or patterned dresses/top and skirt. *Optional:* Headband or scarf.

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Year 6 will be learning about the topic '**Anglo Saxons**'.

As part of this day, we would like the children to come to school dressed as if they were from that period of History. A list of suggestions and example pictures of outfits can be found below:



Boys – Dark trousers, old sheet/ large t-shirt or shirt to make a tunic, rope or leather belt to tie.

Girls – Long dress or large t-shirt or shirt to make a long tunic, rope or leather belt to tie and a head scarf.
