English

Tall story - (you will need a partner to work with)

Your partner writes in the present tense - the story is happening NOW! You write in the past tense - the story happened EARLIER!

Decide who your 'tall story' is about, e.g. the cat! Your partner writes a short sentence to start us off. Remind them to write as if it is happening NOW! You then write the same sentence but in the past tense (as if it happened yesterday).

. Now you write the next sentence - make it short but incredible! Your partner copies you, but writes their sentence in the present tense.. Keep going until you each have a really tall story.

Please bring your tall stories into school.

Science

Write a set of instructions which describe how to make a sound using some saucepans. Try to explain why your technique makes the saucepans produce a sound which we can hear.



Remember to use the word 'vibrations' in your explanation.

Maths

Factors and Multiples Game

This is a game for two players.

The first player chooses a positive even number that is less than 50, and crosses it out on the grid. The second player chooses a number to cross out. The number must be a factor or multiple of the first number.

Players continue to take it in turns to cross out numbers, at each stage choosing a number that is a factor or multiple of the number just crossed out by the other player.

The first person who is unable to cross out a number loses.
