<p align="center">Physical Development</p> <p align="center">Visit a park and use the equipment to build your gross motor skills</p> <p>As the weather is improving, spend more time outdoors using your gross motor skills to explore slides, monkey bars, swings, roundabouts etc. You can send in a photo of you doing some good gross motor exercises!</p>	<p align="center">Literacy</p> <p align="center">Write a factfile about a planet in our solar system</p> <p>Using a book or the internet, research a planet of your choice and learn some interesting facts about them. Fill in the factfile sheet and bring it back into school to share with your friends.</p> <p align="right"></p>	<p align="center">RE</p> <p align="center">Begin to recognise the Hail Mary</p> <p>Using the colouring sheet, sit with your child and read them the Hail Mary. Ask them if they recognise it and talk about when they might have heard it. Give them time to colour it in and then stick it up somewhere special in your home.</p> <p align="right"></p>
<p align="center">Maths</p> <p align="center">Learn to count backwards from 20 to 0</p> <p>Using the stimulus of a rocket blasting off into space, learn to count backwards from 20 to 0: BLAST OFF! You could even try writing the numbers to practise formation.</p>	<p align="center">Topic</p> <p align="center">Decorate a pair of 'underpants' that an alien would love!</p> <p>Use the template to create a spectacular pair of undies that the aliens would love. If you haven't read any of the Alien's love underpants series at home you might want to wait until we have read it in school.
