<p style="text-align: center;">English - reading</p> <p>Write a book review of your favourite book. Write the title, author and illustrator. Tell us about the book. What do you like about it? Is there anything you dislike about it? You can present your book review in whatever style and format you wish. You can use the computer if you wish.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">English</p> <p>Write an acrostic poem about rivers. Use the sheet provided to help you to set it out. Remember that poems do not have to rhyme and remember to use interesting adjectives.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">Science</p> <p>Draw (or paint) a detailed picture of a flower and label the parts.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">French</p> <p>Draw a cartoon of characters meeting and introducing themselves. Use speech bubbles and the introductory French phrases we have been learning.</p> <p>The characters can be very simple stick people, if you wish.</p>
<p style="text-align: center;">Topic – Geography</p> <p>Draw and label a diagram of the water cycle. Use the key words we learnt from our Geography lesson (precipitation, collection, evaporation, condensation).</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> <p>Using your knowledge from our maths lessons, complete the place value sheet.</p> 	<p style="text-align: center;">RE</p> <p>Write a prayer about your home and decorate around it, using your own ideas and words. You may want to thank God for your family and for the support your home provides you.</p> <p>The prayers can be added to your prayer book.</p>	<p style="text-align: center;">Mathematics</p> <p>Find five different types of food in the kitchen which have the weight written on the packaging (i.e, bag of sugar, tin of beans etc).</p> <p>Draw them in order, from lightest to heaviest, writing their weigh underneath. Write three comparison statements. For example, the bag of sugar is heavier than the jar of jam.</p>
