## Home Learning Project

Year 3/4

### Weekly Maths Task (1 per day)

All worksheet based (see pack or parentmail attachments) with extension possibilities

- Fraction tiles. Extension – write equivalent fractions
- Cut out fractions – make "wholes" from different pieces and record them  
Example –  $\frac{1}{2} + \frac{1}{4} + \frac{1}{4} = 1$
- Multiplication machines. Extension – create your own multiplication machine! It could be greater than x12
- Knowing division facts. Extension – write related multiplication calculations for each calculation. And/or – create your own division problems for family members to solve.
- Which operation? Complete the word problems. Extension – change the facts (cost/number) and solve the new problems.

Each day, either practise times tables or do a minute maths (see pack or parentmail attachment)

### Weekly Reading Task (1 per day)

Read "On Rocky Ground". There are seven activities to spread over the week based on this material, which I have separated over the 5 days:

- Matching and Multiple choice.
- Find and copy and Underline or highlight
- Label
- Sequencing
- True or false

Any additional time can be spent reading a book of your choice, independently.

Remember - still read with an adult once a day too!

### Weekly Spelling Task (1 per day)

See spelling grid for this term.

Practise by

- looking up words in the dictionary
- Look, cover, write, check
- Split the work into phonemes and record in different colours

### Weekly Writing Task (1 per day)

Apostrophes based this week. Read the summary of the rules in the pack/ attached to parentmail then complete one a day from the list:

- Missing treasure. Extension – can you write the beginning of the story before this part?
- Identifying apostrophes
- Plural belonging. Extension – make up your own examples using plural nouns and apostrophes.
- Identifying apostrophes for plurals
- Using apostrophes with plurals. Extension – use one of the examples to inspire your own story.

Optional extra – Checking apostrophes.

## Weekly Learning Project

- *Rock comparing: If you have a garden or your parents are willing and able to take you on a walk, collect some stones and rocks. Draw them and record the differences between them. Can you identify the type of rock using your knowledge from this term or by looking it up online?*
- *RE: There are two summaries of St Lucy's life (see pack or Parentmail attachment). Pick the one that you feel comfortable reading. After you have read it, create a fact file on St Lucy. You could include a picture of how you think she might have looked.*
- *RE: complete activities on this week's copy of The Word. If you were unable to pick up the hard copies from school, please go to <http://www.wednesdayword.org/home/index.htm>*
- *Pick something in your house and do a tonal sketch of it. Focus on the parts that have dark, light and mid tones.*

### *Physical Activity – 30 mins each day*

- *Get a timer! How many star jumps can you do in 2 minutes? Have some water and see if you can repeat your score!  
Try a different exercise we have learnt (the plank, burpees, running on the spot) and see if you can beat your score.*
- *Go outside and practise bouncing and catching a ball. Play catch if someone is available to play with you.*
- *Use toys at home that will help keep you active (trampoline, hool-a-hoop, skipping ropes, Wii-fit) and spend at least 30 minutes a day using them.*
- *Make up a dance routine to a favourite song. Can you teach it to someone else? Perhaps you could record it to send to a member of your family who lives somewhere else?*
- *Get active and help around the house! Maybe you could help gardening, making beds, dusting etc. Ask your carer if there is something that will help them.*
