

Number bonds to 20

Start by placing some counters, stones or coins on the tens frame. Recognise and write the number bond to 10 that is made from the counters and the empty spaces. Then record the number bond to 20 that you can see (including the blank tens frame underneath).

If you write the **one** of the **teen number** in a **different colour** it will help you to notice that number bonds to 20 are the same as number bonds to 10, just with another 10 added on to one of the numbers. Please see the example given.

You can record this in your exercise books or on paper if you don't have your exercise books.

Find attached two tens frames just in case you do not have your resource pack.

4 + 6 = 10
4 + 16 = 20
