CHURCHES TO REOPEN FOR PRIVATE PRAYER

Places of worship across England have now reopened for individual prayer. This move recognises the spiritual and mental health benefits for people being able to pray in their place of worship, and that for some people this cannot be replicated by praying at home.

New guidance will be published shortly to ensure the limited reopening of places of worship can be done safely and in line with social distancing guidelines.

This will recommend the thorough cleaning of shared spaces, and hand cleansing at entry and exit.

While individual prayer is now permitted, communally led prayer, worship or devotion such as services, evensong, informal prayer meetings, Mass, Jummah or Kirtan will not be possible at this stage. Opening times for the local church are listed below.
